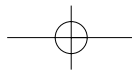

## About Neale

Originally from the Marley area of Ballinteer, Neale is currently living in Kingston, Ballinteer. Neale along with his brother and two sisters was educated locally at Taney National School, Dundrum and Wesley College, Ballinteer.

Neale graduated from UCD in 2005 earning a BA in History and an MA in Politics. Having previously worked locally as a schools rugby coach; Neale spent from 2005 to 2007 working first as an Advisor to Gay Mitchell MEP in Brussels and then as an Aid Worker in West Africa. He has been a member of the Fine Gael party since 2002.

A playing member of Old Wesley RFC, Neale is a keen sportsman and is heavily involved in a number of local clubs and voluntary organisations. He is currently employed by the Houses of the Oireachtas as Parliamentary Assistant to Olivia Mitchell TD.



## New school year – same problems!

A recent Fine Gael survey has revealed information showing the dire state of schools in our area with 58% of schools forced to use prefabs. Even more astounding is that in 1 in 4 classrooms are prefabs! This means that 1,385 children in our area are being taught in prefabs.

Fine Gael carried out a survey across all 12 Dublin constituencies where 172 schools responded to a comprehensive questionnaire about their use of temporary accommodation.

This Fine Gael survey paints a depressing picture but it is one that is familiar to all those involved in education throughout our area. This survey result shows that prefabs are a mainstay in Dublin South schools with:

- 1 in 4 classes are in a prefab;
- 1,385 pupils in temporary accommodation;
- 58% of schools forced to use prefabs;
- Schools having prefabs in place for up to 37 years;

However, instead of pressure being alleviated on overcrowded classrooms, the situation is set to deteriorate even further with schools expecting an

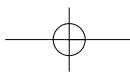
increase in pupil numbers in September 2008. The problem of overcrowding classes in prefabs will become even worse.

The fact that so many local schools are being forced to use prefabs is a damning indictment of the neglect of education and, more than anything shows the dire situation in which primary schools have been left.

### Marlay Update

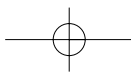
Following the unveiling of the new Marlay Park master plan last year the Council are now pursuing with their first stage.

This will see the creation of a Regional Playground of 2 hectares in area, replacing the existing play area which is over twenty-five years old. With a view to gauging public reaction the Council displayed their plans through the summer and submissions were accepted until the 20th August.

After viewing the plans and talking with local residents, I wrote to the Council suggesting that they consider relocating the proposed playground to a more accessible area at the Northern end of the Park accessible from either of the Grange Road entrances.
